Voices of Tomorrow Jr.

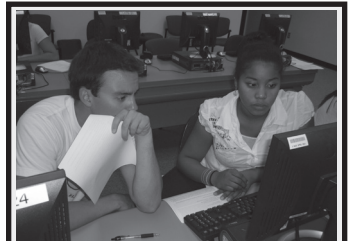
